Release Notes Version 7.4

Overview

In this document you will learn all about the new features and improvements in version 7.4 of the Dashboard.

Deeplinks with # are supported

A BrandMaker system is configured with brandmaker.login.sso.redirect-login to automatically redirect the login page to the SSO server. This causes users to be redirected and log in to the SSO server even after clicking on deeplinks.

Previously, after logging in via a deeplink with search#, the user was only taken to the search page. This has been optimized. The functionality has been expanded to handle such URL fragments correctly. Now, when a user clicks on a deeplink with #, this also executes the search stored in the link.



Expanded widget functionality

The two widgets Link and Link Carousel have been expanded with the following options for communication:

mailto

Example: mailto:name@domain.com opens a new e-mail draft to the recipient preset in the widget in the local e-mail client. Subject, CC, BCC and Body are available as additional optional parameters.

Example with prefilled subject: mailto:name@domain.com?subject=Urgent

tel

Example: tel:+15555551212 starts a call via telephone services software.

skype

Example: skype:profile name calls the Skype name using Skype.

Callto

Example: callto:userid@domain.com starts a call via Microsoft Teams.

Widget border color now customizable

As of version 7.4. you can set the border color for each widget individually in the Display field of the widget editor using an RGBA color picker. The color white (255,255,255,1) thus removes the frame. You can also set the alpha value for transparency to 0 without changing the actual RGB color values.



More formatting and layout options in text widget

When setting up or customizing a text widget, version 7.4 gives you a toolbar with more options than before. You can now align the text vertically in the widget. In addition, the format options Bold, Italic, and Underlined are available. In addition, the text color can be customized.
