Overview

In this document you will learn more about the new features and improvements in version 7.4 of the Review Manager.

Links in annotations

Reviewers now have the choice to include a file link in an annotation instead of a file attachment. Whereas previously you could only attach one file per annotation, by adding a link it is now possible to send multiple files at once with an annotation.



A link also comes in handy if the file is very large, such as a video, and you don't want to attach it. Basically, you can link to any collection of assets in the Media Pool or externally to an entire folder in SharePoint, OneDrive, Cloud, etc. Clicking the link opens the target in a new browser tab.



Global comments and mentions

@-Mentions are now available to review participants in global comments and mentions.

It is thus possible to mention other users in comments via @mention. The mentioned user is automatically notified about the mention via e-mail or in-app notification. The user can then jump directly from the notification to the Review Manager.



Users who were not previously invited to participate, but are mentioned with @ in a review, are automatically added to the review as a new participant with the Reviewer role.

Each mentioned participant will receive an e-mail notification regardless of whether they are already in the participant list.

If a mentioned user is already a participant in the review, their existing role in the review remains untouched by this.

If a review participant does not have the right to manage the participants of the review, they may only select and mention persons from the original participant list with @Mention. This participant cannot add new participants by mentioning them.
